WHEREAS Wirral Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") is the local planning authority as respects the land in the Borough more particularly described in the first schedule hereto

AND WHEREAS the Council is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the class specified in the second schedule hereto should not be carried out on the said land unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

- 1. THE COUNCIL HEREBY DIRECTS in pursuance of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977/81 that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in the second schedule hereto on the land described in the first schedule hereto
- 2. THIS DIRECTION may be cited as "The Wirral Borough Council (Caldy/Thurstaston) Direction 1982" and shall come into force on the date on which notice thereof is first published

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THOSE pieces or parcels of land situated within the parishes of Caldy and Thurstaston in the Borough of Wirral in the County of Merseyside which are delineated on the plan annexed hereto and thereon surround by a red line or a blue line

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

The development described in paragraph 1 of Class II of Schedule I of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977/81.
