Within Policy WD4, United Utilities welcomes the amendments to paragraphs 6.42 which insert the word 'sewer' in the context of flood risk. Whilst we welcome this change, we wish to continue to highlight that the local plan does not explicitly refer to the sewer flood risk which we have identified at various allocations / regeneration areas within the plan which could be material to the design and developable area for these locations. This matter was addressed in detail in our response to the Examination (United Utilities response to Matter 9). This statement identifies the affected locations and recommends wording to reflect the on-site sewer flood risk. To avoid repetition, the sewer flood risk locations and the associated recommended policy wording is not repeated here. However, a copy of our statement is enclosed for ease of reference.

If sewer flood risk is not reflected in changes to text within the local plan, we would strongly advise that the risk of sewer flooding should at least be included in an update to the Strategic Flood Risk Assessment (SFRA). This reflects the planning practice guidance (PPG) at Paragraph: 001 Reference ID: 7-001-20220825 of the PPG which states:

'Strategic flood risk assessments show all sources of flood risk, now and in the future.'

Normal processes for preparing planning applications would ordinarily include reference to a SFRA. This reflects Paragraph: 004 Reference ID: 7-004-20220825 of the PPG states:

'Planning authorities and developers can investigate measures to control the risk of flooding affecting the site. Early discussions with relevant flood risk management authorities, reference to Strategic Flood Risk Assessments and any programme of flood and coastal erosion risk management schemes will help to identify such opportunities.'

It is therefore critical that SFRAs identify known flood risk from all sources.
