TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950

WHEREAS the County Council of the County Palatine of Chester are the local planning authority for the Borough of Bebington in the said County

AND WHEREAS under an Agreement made the fourteenth day of April 1955 the said County Council delegated to the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Bebington (hereinafter called "the Borough Council") in respect of the area of the said Borough and subject to certain conditions and reservations (which so far as material for the purpose of this Direction have been complied with) all the functions of the said County Council under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947 (except Sections 17, 25 and 29) and under any orders or regulations made thereunder

AND WHEREAS the Borough Council are satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of amenity that development of the classes specified in the Second Schedule hereto should not be carried out in the area specified in the First Schedule hereto unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

- 1. THE BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY DIRECT in pursuance of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development of the Classes specified in the Second Schedule hereto in the area described in the First Schedule hereto
- 2. This Direction may be cited as "The Borough of Bebington (29 Shore Drive) Direction 1956" and shall come into force on the date on which notice hereof is served on the owner and occupier of the land contained in the area specified in the First Schedule hereto

THE FIRST SCHEDULE


All that land contained within the curtilage of the dwellinghouse known as 29, Shore Drive, New Ferry, within the Borough of Bebington

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Class $\overline{\underline{I}}$ (1) and (2) (Development within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse) and Class $\overline{\underline{II}}$ (1) (Sundry minor operations)
